BOARD UPDATE

Our June 2012 Symposium at Adelphi University in Long Island, NY, USA, promises to be a wonderful event. The Symposium Committee and the Long Island Planning Committee have been working very hard to make it a success. They received an overwhelming number of abstract submissions, and many group workers from all over the world will be presenting in Long Island. The 2011 Symposium in Long Beach was a financial and organizational success, and we are expecting similar success in Long Island. Information about registration/housing for Long Island is available. The Symposium site will offer several housing options at various rates. Consider arriving a day or two early to Long Island to attend the International Clinical Supervision Conference at Adelphi which is linked with AASWG at Adelphi.

The AASWG Commission on Group Work in Social Work Education is finalizing a protocol to allow members to request funding from AASWG for special projects; AASWG wants members to initiate projects supporting the AASWG group work mission to promote and strengthen group work. This past year AASWG offered support to a project to train youth workers in NYC and San Francisco. The project has been an enormous success, and it provides a wonderful model for other endeavors. In addition, the Commission is actively engaged in supporting/completing group work research and writing projects, including Symposium Proceedings, and other publishing projects. The New Jersey Proceedings will be ready very soon; the Chicago and Montreal Proceedings are near completion; two AASWG books published by CSWE are progressing to second editions; and Mark Macgowan's research articles related to the AASWG Standards will be published soon.

Because the AASWG Board approved an increase in annual chapter support payments (as well as approving a distribution of funds to chapters generated through our Organizational Membership income), our chapters will receive significant income support this year. The Chapter Development Committee is distributing these chapter support funds. AASWG continues to appreciate the enormous contributions made by our chapters across the world. Many of our chapters have held exciting events for their local members in the past few months.

The Membership Committee just completed a large mailing to reach out for 2012 renewals from 2011 members not yet renewed for 2012, and 2010 members who failed to renew in 2011. Renewals and new memberships for 2012 have been arriving steadily, and 2012 membership

Also this summer, we will be represented by an AASWG table at the international IASSW/IFSW/ICSWConference to be held in Stockholm, Sweden. Other promotional opportunities are already planned or are in the planning stage.
